Learning can be done in a variety of ways to increase behavior changes in students after the learning process. Therefore, education must continue to have development innovations in every learning process to provide relevant benefits for students in their learning process. The development of educational innovation can also be a solution to problems in education and can improve the quality of competitive education. Traveling class, as a variation in learning that is carried out outside the classroom, this learning can be done by visiting historical places, museums, squares, zoos, the environment around the school, and visiting other places as learning resources. Traveling class-based learning can be done by going to surrounding locations or locations that require transportation. Traveling class in general is almost the same as the outing class method. According to Rahmawati and Nazarullail [3], outing class is a method used as an effort to bring children closer to real life, namely the community environment. Outing classes are carried out with activities that are outside the classroom that have been planned, this is different from traveling classes with a learning concept that is carried out with learning as is the case with field trips. Field Trip is a learning method that invites students to visit certain objects in order to add and expand their insight into the objects studied [4]. Based on this definition, it can be seen that traveling classes are different, because traveling classes also apply learning on the go, namely the use of bus transportation tools. Traveling class is a learning with the concept of riding a bus around while learning, this was conveyed by the PKM-VGK UNISRI Team who conducted a "Traveling Class" with the Werkudara Bus [5]. Based on these findings, traveling classes are interesting to study, this will make a positive contribution to the world of education in competitive education.

This is usually for a certain period of time and does not last long. In general, learning saturation can be caused by many factors.

Another opinion from Aminuriyah et al. [9] stated that the factors of saturation are caused by less varied learning, the learning atmosphere does not change, learning is only done in certain places, lack of entertainment, and protracted mental tension. Based on the opinions of these experts, it can be seen that in the learning process it is not easy to prepare fun learning. Learning in the classroom is often saturated in students. Saturation is also caused by learning that according to students lacks variety. Learning can be varied by the existence of traveling class-based learning, as a variation in learning carried out outside the classroom. This activity can increase students' motivation to learn because learning is more interesting. According to Hattie [10], motivation is one of the factors for the success of student learning outcomes.

This learning can be done by visiting historical places, museums, squares, zoos, the environment around the school, and visiting other places as learning resources. Traveling class-based learning can be done by going to surrounding locations or locations that require transportation. Learning that is carried out by traveling around the school can go directly to the location by walking, but this learning can also take advantage of bus transportation that is designed for the learning process to take place. Bus transportation has now developed rapidly so that buses can also be used as educational innovations. The use of this bus transportation can be used as a learning to travel around to visit learning resources or directly practice in it. Learning with traveling classes can be expected to be a boring learning solution, besides that students can also have direct experience in the learning process. As Dewey [11], emphasizes effective learning is rooted in hands-on experience. Through the classroom travel program, students can build more meaningful knowledge. The application of traveling class can also be used as a character strengthening in accordance with the goals of the national educatioOn system. UNESCO [12] stated that education introducing cultural diversity can increase tolerance of understanding between cultures, so that this learning can also be a tour in visiting cultural diversity.

Shadow teacher of SDN Nayu Barat II Surakarta Rendi Setiawan explained, learning outside the classroom students will be faster to respond and respond to the material provided. In addition, through learning outside the classroom, students do not get bored

quickly. Traveling class-based learning is an alternative in future education to improve the quality of meaningful and competitive education, in addition to traveling class-based learning as learning that introduces regional resources or resources owned by the region to students. Traveling class-based learning can also be a development and exploration for students in knowing and developing the potential that exists in their area. This learning, in addition to visiting tourist attractions, can also visit the environment around the school to increase experience or insight for students about their local wisdom, can also do learning in learning, for example on the bus, it can be a traffic order learning and other learning in accordance with the material taught.

THE PKM VGK UNISRI TEAM [13], carried out the PKM VGK "Traveling Class", namely by utilizing the Werkudara bus to travel around the city of Solo while studying. The implementation of the traveling class was enthusiastically between students and teachers. The learning process takes place interactively, where students listen and actively answer. It is not uncommon for students who teach to provide examples of materials in the surrounding environment, such as buildings outside the bus so that students can observe. Based on this, it can be known that in the implementation of traveling classes, learning can be carried out in transportation, one of which is by using buses as transportation that are used by learning in it and learning according to the environment.

Traveling class-based learning as an innovative and effective learning process improves the quality of meaningful and competitive learning. The learning process is carried out by contextual learning, interactive, and attracts the attention of students in the learning process carried out.
